

## LIFTS MANAGER

The Lifts Manager will oversee all operations within the lift department which includes: in-season operations, maintenance, safety and regulatory compliance, staffing, scheduling and training. This will be a year-round salaried position and candidates must have prior experience. Job reports to Manager of Operations.

- Responsible for ensuring guest and department staff safety including all safety protocol and procedures (company, state, and federal safety rules/regulations/policies).
- Responsible for training, scheduling and disciplining department staff.
- Responsible for managing budgets and fiscal responsibilities including staffing, equipment and other expenses
